Daniel J. Marxo passed away suddenly on Tuesday, November 23, 2021, at Wellington Regional Medical Center. Daniel was born in Derby, Connecticut on August 7, 1965 to Doris Marxo and the late Thomas Marxo, Sr.

In 1983, Daniel graduated from Emmett O'Brien Technical High School in Ansonia, Connecticut, and moved to Florida in mid-1980s with his last residence being in West Palm Beach, Florida.
