Joseph Thomas Euliano, left this earth to be with his Lord in Heaven Wednesday, September 25th, 2019 at 79 years of age. His college sweetheart and beloved wife Diana Craggs Euliano was at his side when he succumbed to complications after surgery in Palms West Hospital at 5:45 p.m. They had just celebrated their 58th wedding anniversary. Joseph and Diana have resided in Royal Palm Beach, Florida since 2004. He is survived by his four children, Kim Stotridge, Karen Adomi (Bob), Kristin Rodgers (Bob) and Joe Euliano Jr. (Kelly) and seven grandchildren, Nicholas, Max, Mayu, Ella, Ava, Aiden and Lillian.
